Article X11A Synopsis.

Members of the Franklin Rod and Gun Club, Inc. shall be assessed Seventy Five Dollars (\$75.00) per annum, due and payable at the Annual Meeting, in addition to the regular dues. This assessment may be reduced at the rate of Five (\$5.00) per hour for up to Fifteen Hours (15) of work provided to the Club in any of the following categories; A Scheduled Club Functions. B. Scheduled Work Parties, C. Scheduled Committee Meetings. D. Non-Scheduled Work activity that directly benefits the Club (If properly authenticated by the affected Committee Chairman or any member in good standing, on the forms provided). E. The member may earn one (1) hour credit for attending any regular Club meeting. (See Bylaw Booklet for actual wording - as this amount is subject to periodic change in the same manner as a Bylaw)

**** Please Note ****

Both the applicant and the sponsoring member must be in attendance at the meeting during which the application is to be voted. Any member in good standing may sponsor an applicant, but he or she is limited to sponsor one (1) new member every six (6) months.
